AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 532

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 3, strike "Program" and substitute "Task Force"; strike beginning with "requiring" in line 4 down through "providers;" in line 9 and substitute "establishing an Osteoporosis Prevention and Education Task Force in the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene; providing for the composition of the Task Force; requiring the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene to designate the chairman of the Task Force; requiring the Department to provide staff for the Task Force;"; in line 9, strike "Department" and substitute "Task Force"; in line 10, strike "and to gather certain data" and substitute "; requiring the Task Force to make certain recommendations to the Department about certain osteoporosis initiatives; authorizing the Task Force to hold public hearings and solicit information from certain persons"; in line 11, strike "make a certain evaluation and to"; strike beginning with "establishing" in line 12 down through "members;" in line 14; in line 16, strike "requiring the Department to seek a certain federal waiver;" and substitute "requiring the Task Force to carry out its responsibilities to the extent funding is available;"; in line 18, strike "program" and substitute "Task Force"; in line 27, strike "13-1610" and substitute "13-1606"; and in line 28, strike "Program" and substitute "Task Force".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, in line 7, strike "PROGRAM" and substitute "<u>TASK FORCE</u>"; and strike in their entirety lines 13 through 32, inclusive.

On page 4, strike in their entirety lines 1 through 18, inclusive, and substitute:

- "(A) THERE IS AN OSTEOPOROSIS PREVENTION AND EDUCATION TASK FORCE IN THE DEPARTMENT.
 - (B) THE TASK FORCE CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING 16 MEMBERS:
 - (1) THE DEPARTMENT'S OSTEOPOROSIS COORDINATOR; AND

- (2) THE FOLLOWING 15 MEMBERS, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR: A REPRESENTATIVE OF A WOMEN'S HEALTH <u>(I)</u> ORGANIZATION; (II)NINE HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS REPRESENTING THE FOLLOWING PROFESSIONS: 1. RADIOLOGY; <u>2.</u> **ORTHOPEDICS**; <u>3.</u> **NURSING**; <u>4.</u> PHYSICAL THERAPY; <u>5.</u> RHEUMATOLOGY; <u>6.</u> **NUTRITION**; <u>7.</u> SOCIAL WORK; 8. GERIATRICS; AND <u>9.</u> PHARMACY; (III)TWO INDIVIDUALS WITH OSTEOPOROSIS; (IV) ONE PUBLIC HEALTH EDUCATOR; ONE EXPERT IN BONE AND OSTEOPOROSIS RESEARCH, (V)
- (VI) ONE LOCAL HEALTH OFFICER, OR THE LOCAL HEALTH OFFICER'S DESIGNEE.

- (C) THE SECRETARY SHALL DESIGNATE THE CHAIRMAN OF THE TASK FORCE.
 - (D) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE STAFF FOR THE TASK FORCE.
- (E) A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS SERVING ON THE TASK FORCE IS A QUORUM.
- (F) THE TASK FORCE SHALL CONDUCT A NEEDS ASSESSMENT TO IDENTIFY:
- (1) AVAILABLE TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE AND EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS AND PROGRAMS CONCERNING OSTEOPOROSIS NATIONWIDE;
- (2) THE LEVEL OF PUBLIC AND PROFESSIONAL AWARENESS ABOUT OSTEOPOROSIS;
- (3) THE NEEDS OF OSTEOPOROSIS PATIENTS, AND THE FAMILIES AND CAREGIVERS OF OSTEOPOROSIS PATIENTS;
- (4) THE NEEDS OF HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS, INCLUDING PHYSICIANS, NURSES, AND MANAGED CARE ORGANIZATIONS, THAT PROVIDE SERVICES TO OSTEOPOROSIS PATIENTS:
 - (5) THE SERVICES AVAILABLE TO OSTEOPOROSIS PATIENTS;
- (6) THE EXISTENCE OF OSTEOPOROSIS TREATMENT GROUPS, SUPPORT GROUPS, AND REHABILITATION SERVICES; AND
- (7) THE AMOUNT AND LOCATION OF BONE DENSITY TESTING EQUIPMENT.
- (G) THE TASK FORCE SHALL MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT ABOUT:

(1) ANY LEGISLATION OR REGULATION THAT MAY BE NECESSARY OR DESIRABLE TO IMPLEMENT THIS SUBTITLE;".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, strike in their entirety lines 19 and 20, inclusive; in line 21, strike "(1)" and substitute "(2)"; in the same line, strike "DEVELOP" and substitute "DEVELOPING"; strike beginning with "THE" in line 26 down through "(IV)" in line 27; in line 29, strike "(V)" and substitute "(IV)"; in line 31, strike "(VI)" and substitute "(V)"; in line 32, strike "(VII)" and substitute "(VII)".

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 5, in line 1, strike "(IX)" and substitute "(VIII)"; in lines 4, 8, and 11, strike "(2)", "(3)", and "(4)", respectively, and substitute "(3)", "(4)", and "(5)", respectively; in the same lines, in each instance, strike "DEVELOP" and substitute "DEVELOPING"; in line 10, strike "(1)" and substitute "(2)"; in the same line, strike the second "AND"; in line 11, strike "MAINTAIN" and substitute "MAINTAINING"; in line 14, strike "DISSEMINATE" and substitute "DISSEMINATING"; and in line 21, after "STATE" insert "; AND

- (6) GATHERING APPROPRIATE DATA TO TRACK THE INCIDENCE OF OSTEOPOROSIS IN THE STATE.
- (H) THE TASK FORCE MAY HOLD PUBLIC HEARINGS AND SOLICIT INFORMATION FROM ANY PERSON, ORGANIZATION, OR GROUP AS THE TASK FORCE DEEMS NECESSARY".

On pages 5 and 6, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 22 on page 5 through line 2 on page 6, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 5

On page 6, strike in their entirety lines 3 through 5, inclusive; in line 6, strike "13-1607." and substitute "<u>13-1603.</u>"; strike beginning with the colon in line 7 down through "(2)" in line 10; in line 10, strike "ITS" and substitute "<u>THE</u>"; and strike beginning with the comma in line 10 down through "SUBTITLE," in line 11 and substitute "<u>OF THE TASK FORCE</u>".
