AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 453

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, at the top of the page, insert "<u>EMERGENCY BILL</u>"; in line 2, strike "Property Tax" and substitute "<u>Baltimore City</u>"; in line 4, after "sales" insert "<u>in Baltimore City</u>; making this <u>Act an emergency measure</u>"; and in line 5, after "sales" insert "<u>in Baltimore City</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 22, strike "subparagraph" and substitute "<u>SUBPARAGRAPHS</u>"; in the same line, after "(iii)" insert "<u>AND (IV)</u>"; and strike beginning with "THE" in line 23 down through "2." in line 26.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 1, after line 26, insert:

"(III) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (IV) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, IN BALTIMORE CITY, THE HIGH-BID PREMIUM SHALL BE 20% OF THE AMOUNT BY WHICH THE HIGHEST BID EXCEEDS THE GREATER OF:

- 1. THE LIEN AMOUNT; OR
- <u>40% OF THE PROPERTY'S FULL CASH VALUE."</u>.

On page 2, in lines 1, 4, 10, and 17, strike "(iii)", "(iv)", "(v)", and "(vi)", respectively, and substitute "(IV)", "(V)", "(VI)", and "(VII)", respectively.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 21 and 22, inclusive, and substitute:

HB0453/375467/1 W&M Amendments to HB 453 Page 2 of 2

"SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all of the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted."
