AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 293

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “Senator Green” and substitute “Senators Green, Colburn, Ferguson, Forehand, and Jimeno”; in line 4, strike “only” and substitute “within a crosswalk”; in the same line, strike “in a” and substitute “through the”; in line 6, after “guard;” insert “requiring that a certain fine that is collected by the District Court be remitted to a certain county or municipal corporation that employs a certain school crossing guard;”; and after line 11, insert:

“BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

Section 7-302(b)

Annotated Code of Maryland

(1998 Replacement Volume and 2001 Supplement)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, after line 23, insert:

“Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

7-302.

(b) (1) If a parking or impounding fine, penalty, or forfeiture, or a fine, penalty, or forfeiture relating to violation of housing, building, fire, health, or sanitation codes, or a Mass Transit Fare Payment Statute, or a fine or penalty relating to failure to pay the prescribed toll at a highway or vehicular crossing is collected by the District Court pursuant to a local ordinance, law, or regulation of a political subdivision or municipality, or pursuant to a regulation of an agency of State government authorized to regulate parking of motor vehicles, or pursuant to a statute pertaining to the payment of mass transit fares, or pursuant to a statute pertaining to the failure to pay tolls, it shall

be remitted to the respective local government, or to the State agency.

(2) A FINE FOR A VIOLATION OF § 21-107 OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE RELATING TO DISOBEYING A LAWFUL ORDER OF A SCHOOL CROSSING GUARD THAT IS COLLECTED BY THE DISTRICT COURT SHALL BE REMITTED TO THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION THAT EMPLOYS THE SCHOOL CROSSING GUARD.”.

On page 2, in line 1, after “(B)” insert “(1)”; and after line 3, insert:

“(2) A FINE FOR A VIOLATION OF PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION THAT IS COLLECTED BY THE DISTRICT COURT SHALL BE REMITTED TO THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION THAT EMPLOYS THE SCHOOL CROSSING GUARD IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 7-302 OF THE COURTS ARTICLE.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 1, in line 26, after “(A)” insert “WITHIN A CROSSWALK,”; and in line 27, strike “IN A” and substitute “THROUGH THE”.
