AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 184, AS AMENDED

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1 of the Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee Amendments (SB0184/804037/2), in lines 9 and 10 of Amendment No. 2, strike "more than once of certain crimes of violence" and substitute "of certain crimes".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2 of the Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee Amendments, strike Amendment No. 4 in its entirety.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3 of the bill, after line 5, insert:

“(C) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, AN INDIVIDUAL IS NOT QUALIFIED TO BE A REGISTERED VOTER IF THE INDIVIDUAL HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF:

(1) A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT CRIME OF VIOLENCE, AS DEFINED IN § 14-101 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE; OR

(2) FIRST DEGREE MURDER UNDER § 2-201 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE, OR SECOND DEGREE MURDER UNDER § 2-204 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE.”.
