AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 184, AS AMENDED

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1 of the Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee Amendments (SB0184/804037/2), in lines 9 and 10 of Amendment No. 2, strike "more than once of certain crimes of violence" and substitute "of certain crimes".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2 of the Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee Amendments, strike Amendment No. 4 in its entirety.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3 of the bill, after line 5, insert:

“(C) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, AN INDIVIDUAL IS NOT QUALIFIED TO BE A REGISTERED VOTER IF THE INDIVIDUAL HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF:

(1) A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT CRIME OF VIOLENCE, AS DEFINED IN §14-101 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE;

(2) RAPE IN THE FIRST DEGREE, UNDER § 3-303 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE IN WHICH THE VICTIM IS A CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF 16 YEARS;

(3) RAPE IN THE SECOND DEGREE, UNDER § 3-304 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE IN WHICH THE VICTIM IS A CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF 16 YEARS;

(4) SEXUAL OFFENSE IN THE FIRST DEGREE, UNDER § 3-305 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE IN WHICH THE VICTIM IS A CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF 16

YEARS; OR

(5) SEXUAL OFFENSE IN THE SECOND DEGREE, UNDER § 3-306 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE IN WHICH THE VICTIM IS A CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF 16 YEARS.”.
