AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL NO. 495, AS AMENDED

(First Reading File Bill)

On page 1 of the Appropriations Committee Amendments (HB0495/244666/1), in line 3 of Amendment No. 2, after "Program;" insert "requiring the Secretary of Human Resources to establish certain demonstration sites according to a certain schedule;"; and in the Appropriations Committee Amendments, strike Amendment No. 4 in its entirety.

On page 4 of the bill, strike beginning with "selected" in line 14 down through "compete" in line 16 and substitute "THAT COMPETES"; in line 18, after "(b)" insert "(1)"; strike beginning with "The" in line 18 down through "jurisdictions" in line 19 and substitute "SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE SECRETARY OF HUMAN RESOURCES SHALL ESTABLISH CHILD SUPPORT DEMONSTRATION SITES IN ALL JURISDICTIONS THAT ARE NOT PRIVATIZED JURISDICTIONS."; and after line 20, insert:

"(2) THE SECRETARY SHALL ESTABLISH AT LEAST:

(I) SEVEN DEMONSTRATION SITES BY NOVEMBER 1, 2002, FOUR OF WHICH SHALL BE THE DEMONSTRATION SITES IN EXISTENCE AS OF JANUARY 1, 2002;

(II) ELEVEN DEMONSTRATION SITES BY JULY 1, 2003;

(III) SIXTEEN DEMONSTRATION SITES BY JULY 1, 2004; AND

(IV) TWENTY-TWO DEMONSTRATION SITES BY JULY 1, 2005.

(3) THE SECRETARY MAY ESTABLISH DEMONSTRATION SITES AT A RATE FASTER THAN REQUIRED BY PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION IF SUFFICIENT FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE IN THE BUDGET.

(Over)

(4) WHEN ESTABLISHING DEMONSTRATION SITES UNDER PARAGRAPH (2)(I) THROUGH (III) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE SECRETARY SHALL CHOOSE JURISDICTIONS THAT ARE GEOGRAPHICALLY DIVERSE.”.
