AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 535

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 5, after the second “the” insert “court-ordered”; in lines 5 and 6, strike “conviction, including probation” and substitute “conviction”; strike beginning with “the” in line 6 down through “Act” in line 7 and substitute “a delayed effective date”; and strike in their entirety lines 9 through 13, inclusive.

On pages 1 and 2, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 21 on page 1 through line 17 on page 2, inclusive.

On page 3, strike in their entirety lines 6 through 9, inclusive; in line 10, strike “4.” and substitute “2.”; and strike beginning with the second comma in line 10 down through the comma in line 11.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 5, after “individual” insert “, in connection with a first conviction,”; and in line 6, before “providing” insert “altering the qualifications for voter registration to allow an individual who has been convicted of a certain crime to qualify to be a registered voter if the individual, in connection with a subsequent conviction, has completed the court-ordered sentence imposed for the conviction and at least a certain number of years has elapsed since the completion of the court-ordered sentence;”.

On page 3, in line 1, after “(ii)” insert “1.”; in the same line, strike the brackets; in the same line, strike “HAS”; in line 3, after “FINES;” insert “OR”; and after line 3, insert:

“2. IN CONNECTION WITH A SUBSEQUENT CONVICTION, HAS COMPLETED THE COURT-ORDERED SENTENCE IMPOSED FOR THE CONVICTION, INCLUDING PROBATION, PAROLE, COMMUNITY SERVICE, RESTITUTIONS, AND FINES,
