## AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 535 (First Reading File Bill)

### AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 5, after the second "the" insert "<u>court-ordered</u>"; in lines 5 and 6, strike "conviction, including probation" and substitute "<u>conviction</u>"; strike beginning with "the" in line 6 down through "Act" in line 7 and substitute "<u>a delayed effective date</u>"; and strike in their entirety lines 9 through 13, inclusive.

On pages 1 and 2, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 21 on page 1 through line 17 on page 2, inclusive.

On page 3, strike in their entirety lines 6 through 9, inclusive; in line 10, strike "4." and substitute "<u>2</u>."; and strike beginning with the second comma in line 10 down through the comma in line 11.

### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 5, after "individual" insert "<u>, in connection with a first conviction</u>,"; and in line 6, before "providing" insert "<u>altering the qualifications for voter registration to allow an individual who has been convicted of a certain crime to qualify to be a registered voter if the individual, in connection with a subsequent conviction, has completed the court-ordered sentence imposed for the conviction and at least a certain number of years has elapsed since the completion of the court-ordered sentence;".</u>

On page 3, in line 1, after "(ii)" insert "<u>1.</u>"; in the same line, strike the brackets; in the same line, strike "HAS"; in line 3, after "FINES;" insert "<u>OR</u>"; and after line 3, insert:

# "2. IN CONNECTION WITH A SUBSEQUENT CONVICTION, HAS COMPLETED THE COURT-ORDERED SENTENCE IMPOSED FOR THE CONVICTION, INCLUDING PROBATION, PAROLE, COMMUNITY SERVICE, RESTITUTIONS, AND FINES,

AND AT LEAST 3 YEARS HAVE ELAPSED SINCE THE COMPLETION OF THE COURT-ORDERED SENTENCE IMPOSED FOR THE CONVICTION, INCLUDING PROBATION, PAROLE, COMMUNITY SERVICE, RESTITUTIONS, AND FINES;".
