AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 675, AS AMENDED

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1 of the bill, strike beginning with “requiring” in line 3 down through “guidelines;” in line 4; and strike beginning with “requiring” in line 6 down through “year;” in line 9 and substitute “requiring each county board of education to develop a system of monitoring indoor air quality for each school under the county board’s jurisdiction using certain guidelines;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

In the Environmental Matters Committee Amendments (HB0675/610312/2), strike Amendment No. 2 in its entirety.

On page 1 of the bill, in line 18, strike “Education” and substitute “Environment”; after line 18, insert “SUBTITLE 10. INDOOR AIR QUALITY.”; strike beginning with “(1)” in line 20 down through “(2)” in line 24; in line 24, after the first “DEPARTMENT” insert “OF EDUCATION”; and strike beginning with “OF” in line 24 down through “ENVIRONMENT” in line 25.

On page 2, strike beginning with “EACH” in line 6 down through “YEAR.” in line 10 and substitute “EACH COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION SHALL DEVELOP A SYSTEM OF MONITORING INDOOR AIR QUALITY FOR EACH SCHOOL UNDER THE COUNTY BOARD’S JURISDICTION USING THE GUIDELINES FOR HEALTHY INDOOR AIR QUALITY ESTABLISHED BY THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY.”.
