# AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1025 (First Reading File Bill)

### AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "Delegate Sher" and substitute "<u>Delegates Sher</u>, <u>Donoghue, Fulton, Goldwater, Kirk, Krysiak, Love, McHale, and Pendergrass</u>"; strike beginning with "Benefits" in line 2 down through "Abuse" in line 3 and substitute "<u>Task Force on Access to Mental Health Treatment for Privately Insured Individuals</u>"; strike beginning with "that" in line 4 down through "insurance" in line 13 and substitute "<u>the Task Force on Access to Mental Health Treatment for Privately Insured Individuals</u>; specifying the duties of the task force; specifying the <u>members of the task force</u>; requiring the Governor to appoint the chairman of the task force; requiring the task force to submit a certain report to the Governor and the General Assembly by a certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to mental health services</u>"; strike in their entirety lines 14 through 18, inclusive; and in line 20, strike "the Laws of Maryland read as follows".

#### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 1 through 4, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 21 on page 1 through line 26 on page 4, inclusive, and substitute:

## "(a) <u>There is a Task Force on Access to Mental Health Treatment for Privately Insured</u> Individuals.

- (b) The task force consists of the following 13 members:
  - (1) Two members of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of the

Senate;

(2) <u>Two members of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of the</u>

House;

(3) The Secretary of the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene or the Secretary's designee;

- (4) The Maryland Insurance Commissioner or the Commissioner's designee;
- (5) The following members appointed by the Governor:
  - (i) One representative of the commercial health insurance industry;
  - (ii) <u>One representative of a commercial health maintenance organization;</u>
  - (iii) One representative of the managed behavioral health care industry;
  - (iv) One representative of the Maryland Hospital Association;
  - (v) One representative of the Mental Health Association of Maryland;
  - (vi) One representative of the Community Behavioral Health Association

of Maryland; and

- (vii) One representative of the pediatric mental health community.
- (c) The Governor shall appoint the chairman of the task force.
- (d) The task force shall study and make recommendations regarding:

(1) The differences in the coverage of mental health services among the public mental health system, commercial health insurers, and commercial health maintenance organizations;

(2) The structure and effectiveness of the mental health care delivery system in the State; and

(3) Compliance by commercial health insurers and health maintenance organizations with the mental health parity requirements under § 15-802 of the Insurance Article and § 19-703.1 of the Health - General Article.

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(e) The task force shall report its findings and recommendations to the Governor, and in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly, on or before December 1, 2003.

<u>SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED</u>, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2002. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and 6 months and, at the end of December 31, 2003, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect."
