AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL NO. 175
(Third Reading File Bill - Committee Reprint)

On page 16, under:

Heading: BOARDS, COMMISSIONS AND OFFICES

Program: DA.05.16

Entitled: Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention

After line 7, insert:

“Further provided that \$250,000 of this general fund appropriation may not be expended until the Governor’s Office of Crime Control and Prevention (GOCCP) has submitted, on or before January 1, 2003, a report setting forth analysis and recommendations regarding the reorganization of victim services to the House Appropriations and Judiciary Committees and the Senate Budget and Taxation and Judicial Proceedings Committees. This report shall also include comments and recommendations from GOCCP’s Victim Services Assessment Program’s State Board of Victim Services and Task Force to Examine Crime Victims’ Rights. The budget committees shall have 45 days to review and comment.”.

Explanation: This language restricts \$250,000 of the general fund appropriation until submission of a report on the reorganization of victims services.
