AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 426

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, after “Hixson,” insert “Kagan, Healey, Finifter, Heller,”; in the same line, strike “Kagan,”; and strike beginning with “establishing” in line 3 down through “State” in line 9 and substitute “prohibiting the governing body of a community college from denying certain individuals eligibility for a certain tuition status under certain circumstances”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 1 and 2, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 19 on page 1 through line 13 on page 2, inclusive, and substitute:

“THE GOVERNING BOARD OF A COMMUNITY COLLEGE MAY NOT DENY AN INDIVIDUAL ELIGIBILITY FOR RESIDENT TUITION STATUS FOR ATTENDANCE AT THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE ON ACCOUNT OF THE INDIVIDUAL’S IMMIGRATION STATUS IF THE INDIVIDUAL HAS THE CAPACITY TO ESTABLISH DOMICILE IN MARYLAND.”
