AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 706

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike “Talbot County” and substitute “Dorchester and Talbot Counties”; in line 3, after the first “of” insert “altering the salary of the State’s Attorney for Dorchester County; prohibiting the State’s Attorney for Dorchester County from engaging in the private practice of law;”; in the same line, after “County;” insert “requiring the State’s Attorney for Talbot County to serve full time;”; in line 6, after “incumbent” insert “State’s Attorney for Dorchester County or the incumbent”; in line 7, strike “Attorney for” and substitute “Attorneys for Dorchester and”; in line 8, strike “County” and substitute “Counties”; and in line 11, strike “40(u)(1)” and substitute “40(j)(1) and (2) and (u)(1)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, after line 17, insert:

“(j) (1) In Dorchester County, the State’s Attorney’s salary shall be [80] 90 percent of the salary of a judge of the District Court of Maryland.

(2) The State’s Attorney shall serve full time AND MAY NOT ENGAGE IN THE PRIVATE PRACTICE OF LAW.”.

On page 2, in line 3, after the second “the” insert “State’s Attorney for Dorchester County or the”; and in line 5, after the first “the” insert “State’s Attorney for Dorchester County and the”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 1, in line 22, strike “may serve part time” and substitute “SHALL SERVE FULL TIME”.
