AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with “Public” in line 2 down through “Facilities” in line 3 and substitute “Public School Facilities”; in line 4, after “of” insert “establishing a new allocation method for certain grants distributed to county boards of education under the Aging Schools program”; in line 12, strike “providing for the abrogation of this Act” and substitute “providing that, if there is any conflict between this Act and a certain other Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern”; and after line 13, insert:

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 15, after “That” insert “the Laws of Maryland read as follows”; after line 15, insert:

“Article - Education

(k) [Beginning with the fiscal year 1999 State budget, the Governor shall include not less

(1) (I) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(II) “LOCAL SQUARE FOOTAGE” MEANS THE TOTAL SQUARE FOOTAGE FOR SCHOOL FACILITIES IN THE COUNTY THAT WERE CONSTRUCTED BEFORE 1960 AND THAT HAVE NOT BEEN RENOVATED SINCE 1960.

(III) “STATEWIDE SQUARE FOOTAGE” MEANS THE TOTAL SQUARE FOOTAGE FOR SCHOOL FACILITIES IN THE STATE THAT WERE CONSTRUCTED BEFORE 1960 AND THAT HAVE NOT BEEN RENOVATED SINCE 1960.

(2) BEGINNING IN FISCAL YEAR 2003, THE STATE SHALL DISTRIBUTE A TOTAL OF \$10,370,000 IN GRANTS TO COUNTY BOARDS UNDER THE AGING SCHOOLS PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE INTERAGENCY COMMITTEE ON SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

(3) EACH COUNTY SHALL RECEIVE A GRANT UNDER THIS SUBSECTION THAT IS EQUAL TO THE PRODUCT OF \$10,370,000 AND THE RATIO OF THE LOCAL SQUARE FOOTAGE TO THE STATEWIDE SQUARE FOOTAGE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Chapter 105 of the Acts of 1997

[(c) Aging School Program.

The following funds shall be provided for the Aging School Program, which shall be administered by the Interagency Committee on Public School Construction, beginning with the Fiscal Year 1998 State budget:

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, after line 26, insert:

“SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, if there is any conflict between the provisions of this Act and the provisions of Chapter \_\_\_\_\_ (S.B. 856) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2002 regarding the Task Force on Public School Facilities or the Aging Schools Program, the provisions of this Act shall govern the work of the Task Force on Public School Facilities or the administration of the Aging Schools Program.”;

in line 27, strike “2.” and substitute “5.”; and strike beginning with “It” in line 28 through “;” in line 30.
