AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1377

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with “exempting” in line 3 down through “guardian” in line 5 and substitute “repealing a prohibition on minors possessing pepper mace; repealing a certain penalty; establishing the intent of the General Assembly”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 15, strike both brackets; strike in their entirety lines 16 through 20, inclusive; in line 21, strike “(5)” and substitute “(4)”; strike in their entirety lines 30 and 31; and in line 32, strike “(4)” and substitute “(3)”.

On page 3, in line 6, strike “(i)”; in the same line, strike “(4)” and substitute “(3)”; in line 9, strike “(ii)” and substitute “(2)”; and strike in their entirety lines 13 through 15, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, after line 15, insert:

“SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That it is the intent of the General Assembly that a school or school board of education may establish policies to limit or prohibit the possession of pepper mace on school property.”;

and in line 16, strike “2.” and substitute “3.”.
