AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 687

(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 2, in line 10, strike “a”; and in the same line, strike “contingency” and substitute “contingencies”.

On page 9, in line 38, strike “PROGRAM” and substitute “PROGRAMS”; on page 14, in line 10, strike “1991” and substitute “1997”; in line 29, strike “schools under local reconstitution in Baltimore City” and substitute “the Baltimore City-State Partnership”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 12, in lines 7 and 28, in each instance, strike “public schools” and substitute “Public School System”; on page 12 in line 19, and on page 13 in line 6, in each instance, strike “Schools” and substitute “School System”; and on page 14, in line 13, strike “of the” and substitute “or the”.

On page 12, strike beginning with “recommendations” in line 8 through “2001” in line 16, inclusive, and substitute “requirements of Chapter ____ (S.B. 856) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2002 as applicable to Baltimore City, the Governor shall include in the State budget for fiscal year 2003 an appropriation for the Baltimore City Public School System that includes at least: (1) \$50,000,000 for the Baltimore City-State Partnership as required by Section 7 of Chapter 105 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1997, as amended by Chapter 420 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2001; (2) \$20,465,079 for the Remedy Plan for the Baltimore City Public School System as required by Section 4 of Chapter 493 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2000, as amended by Chapter 420 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2001; and (3) an additional \$31,380,534 for the Remedy Plan for the Baltimore City Public School System”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 12, in line 18, strike “2007” and substitute “2008”; and strike beginning with “recommendations” in line 20 through “System” in line 25 and substitute “requirements of Chapter ____ (S.B. 856) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2002 as applicable to Baltimore City,

the Governor shall include in the State budgets for fiscal years 2004 through 2008, in each year, an appropriation for the Baltimore City Public School System that includes at least: (1) \$50,000,000 for the Baltimore City-State Partnership; and (2) \$55,000,000 for the Remedy Plan for the Baltimore City Public School System”.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 12, in line 27, strike “2007” and substitute “2008”; strike beginning with “recommendations” in line 29 through “Excellence” in line 30 and substitute “requirements of Chapter _____ (S.B. 856) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2002”; in line 31, strike “2007” and substitute “2008”.
