AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1178

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "and Frush" and substitute "<u>Frush, Bozman, and Cryor</u>"; in lines 5 and 11, in each instance, after "incurred" insert "<u>on September 11, 2001</u>"; and strike beginning with "September 11, 2001" in line 6 down through "attacks" in line 9 and substitute "<u>that date</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, strike in their entirety lines 15 through 29, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, in line 2, strike beginning with "the" through "follows"; and strike in their entirety lines 3 through 35, inclusive, and substitute:

- "(a) (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law and except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, the register of wills shall waive any fees authorized under § 2-206 of the Estates and Trusts Article for the administration of the estate of a decedent who died as a result of wounds or injury incurred on September 11, 2001 as a result of the terrorist attacks against the United States on that date.
- (2) Paragraph (1) of this subsection does not apply to the estate of a decedent whom the register of wills determines was a perpetrator of a terrorist attack against the United States on September 11, 2001.
- (b) (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law and except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, the inheritance tax imposed under § 7-202 of the Tax General Article does not apply to the receipt of property from a decedent who died as a result of wounds or injury incurred on September 11, 2001 as a result of the terrorist attacks against the United States on

that date.

(2) Paragraph (1) of this subsection does not apply to the estate of a decedent whom the register of wills determines was a perpetrator of a terrorist attack against the United States on September 11, 2001.".

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 3, in line 3, after "incurred" insert "on September 11, 2001"; and in line 4, strike "September 11, 2001" and substitute "that date".
