BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 15 **Article - Education** 16 6-306. 17 For fiscal year 2000 and each subsequent fiscal year, the Governor 18 shall include in each year's operating budget funding for the stipends and bonuses

- 7 county board, and remains employed as a classroom teacher in the public school
- 8 system for a minimum of 3 consecutive years shall receive a salary signing bonus of

- 10 (ii) If the individual leaves employment with the public school
- 11 system before the end of the 3-year commitment, the individual shall reimburse the
- 12 State in the amount of \{\\$1,000\}\\$3,000.
- 13 (4) A classroom teacher who holds an advanced professional certificate
- 14 and teaches in a public school identified by the State Board as a reconstitution school,
- 15 a reconstitution-eligible school, or a challenge school shall receive a stipend from the
- 16 State in the amount of \$2,000 for each year that the teacher performs satisfactorily in
- 17 the classroom.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
