2 **Vehicle Laws - Signs Designating Parking Spaces for Individuals with**
3 **Disabilities - Notice of Fine for Violation**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring ~~that a sign designating a new sign erected after a~~
5 certain date that designates a parking space or zone for the use of individuals
6 with disabilities to clearly state the maximum amount of the fine for unlawfully
7 parking in the designated space in violation of a certain provision of law; and
8 generally relating to the content of signs designating parking spaces for
9 individuals with disabilities.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

2 21-1003.

3 (u) A person may not stop, stand, or park a vehicle unless for the use of an
4 individual with a disability, in a space or zone marked as restricted for the use of
5 individuals with disabilities.

6 21-1004.

7 (F) A NEW SIGN ERECTED AFTER OCTOBER 1, 2002 ~~A SIGN DESIGNATING THAT~~
8 DESIGNATES A PARKING SPACE OR ZONE FOR THE USE OF INDIVIDUALS WITH
9 DISABILITIES SHALL CLEARLY STATE THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF THE FINE TO
10 WHICH A PERSON IS SUBJECT FOR PARKING A VEHICLE IN THE PARKING SPACE OR
11 ZONE IN VIOLATION OF § 21-1003(U) OF THIS SUBTITLE.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
13 October 1, 2002.
