1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Motor Vehicle Administration - Drivers' Licenses and Identification Cards -**
3 **Selective Service Administration Registration**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to provide to the
5 Selective Service Administration certain information concerning male
6 applicants of a certain age who apply for a driver's license or identification card
7 under certain circumstances; establishing that a signature on an application for
8 a driver's license or identification card ~~constitutes consent to~~ indicates that the
9 applicant has selected one of the options on the application form concerning the
10 forwarding of certain information to the Selective Service Administration;
11 requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to provide certain information on a
12 certain application; providing that an applicant's refusal to consent to certain
13 information being sent to the Selective Service Administration does not
14 constitute grounds for denial of a driver's license or identification card;
15 requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to forward certain information to
16 the Selective Service Administration in a certain manner; making certain
17 provisions of this Act contingent on certain federal funding; requiring the Motor

1 Vehicle Administrator to take certain actions regarding federal funding to
 2 implement certain provisions of this Act; and generally relating to drivers'
 3 licenses and identification cards.

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
 10 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

11 **Article - Transportation**

12 12-304.

13 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO AN ADULT MALE APPLICANT UNDER THE
 14 AGE OF 26 YEARS.

15 (B) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, THE ADMINISTRATION
 16 SHALL PROVIDE TO THE SELECTIVE SERVICE ADMINISTRATION IN AN ELECTRONIC
 17 FORMAT, FOR PURPOSES OF REGISTRATION WITH THE SELECTIVE SERVICE AS
 18 REQUIRED UNDER FEDERAL LAW, THE NECESSARY INFORMATION CONCERNING A
 19 MALE APPLICANT WHO APPLIES FOR A DRIVER'S LICENSE OR IDENTIFICATION CARD
 20 OR THE RENEWAL OF A DRIVER'S LICENSE OR IDENTIFICATION CARD, INCLUDING
 21 THE APPLICANT'S:

- 22 (1) FULL NAME;
- 23 (2) CURRENT ADDRESS;
- 24 (3) DATE OF BIRTH;
- 25 (4) GENDER;
- 26 (5) DATE OF APPLICATION; AND
- 27 (6) SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER, IF AVAILABLE.

28 (C) (1) A MALE APPLICANT'S SIGNATURE ON THE APPLICATION INDICATES
 29 THAT THE APPLICANT:

 2 FORWARDING OF INFORMATION TO THE SELECTIVE SERVICE ADMINISTRATION
 3 UNDER THIS SECTION.

4 (2) IN ADDITION TO THE INFORMATION REQUIRED UNDER THIS
 5 SUBTITLE OR TITLE 16 OF THIS ARTICLE, AN APPLICATION FORM FOR A DRIVER'S
 6 LICENSE OR IDENTIFICATION CARD OR RENEWAL OF A DRIVER'S LICENSE OR
 7 IDENTIFICATION CARD SHALL:

8 (A) ~~CONTAIN A STATEMENT THAT A MALE APPLICANT'S~~
 9 ~~SIGNATURE CONSTITUTES CONSENT THE MALE APPLICANT:~~

10 (I) HAS ALREADY REGISTERED WITH THE SELECTIVE SERVICE
 11 ADMINISTRATION; OR

12 (II) HAS NOT REGISTERED WITH THE SELECTIVE SERVICE
 13 ADMINISTRATION AND:

14 1. CONSENTS TO FORWARDING THE INFORMATION IN
 15 SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION TO THE SELECTIVE SERVICE ADMINISTRATION;

17 (H) ~~PROVIDE AN OPPORTUNITY FOR A MALE APPLICANT TO~~
 18 ~~REFUSE TO CONSENT TO THE FORWARDING OF THE INFORMATION IN SUBSECTION~~
 19 ~~(B) OF THIS SECTION TO THE SELECTIVE SERVICE ADMINISTRATION. OR~~

20 2. REFUSES TO CONSENT TO THE FORWARDING OF THE
 21 INFORMATION IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION TO THE SELECTIVE SERVICE
 22 ADMINISTRATION.

23 (D) REFUSAL TO CONSENT TO THE FORWARDING OF THE INFORMATION IN
 24 SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION TO THE SELECTIVE SERVICE ADMINISTRATION
 25 MAY NOT BE GROUNDS FOR DENIAL OF AN APPLICATION FOR A DRIVER'S LICENSE OR
 26 IDENTIFICATION CARD OR RENEWAL OF A DRIVER'S LICENSE OR IDENTIFICATION
 27 CARD.

28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of this Act is
 29 contingent on the receipt by the Motor Vehicle Administration of sufficient federal
 30 funds to pay the Administration's initial start-up costs for computer programming
 31 changes necessary to implement the requirements of Section 1 of this Act related to
 32 the reporting of information to the Selective Service Administration.

33 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Motor Vehicle
 34 Administrator shall initiate and monitor efforts to obtain federal funds for the
 35 purposes stated in Section 2 of this Act and shall report promptly to the Department
 36 of Legislative Services when federal funds have been received by the Administration
 37 and the contingency specified in Section 2 of this Act has been fulfilled.

38 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to Section 2 of
 39 this Act, this Act shall take effect October 1, 2002.
