- 9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 10 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 13 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO AN ADULT MALE APPLICANT UNDER THE 14 AGE OF 26 YEARS.
- 15 (B) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, THE ADMINISTRATION
- 16 SHALL PROVIDE TO THE SELECTIVE SERVICE ADMINISTRATION IN AN ELECTRONIC

- 32 the reporting of information to the Selective Service Administration.

- 34 Administrator shall initiate and monitor efforts to obtain federal funds for the
- 35 purposes stated in Section 2 of this Act and shall report promptly to the Department
- 36 of Legislative Services when federal funds have been received by the Administration
- 37 and the contingency specified in Section 2 of this Act has been fulfilled.
