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**HOUSE BILL 26** 1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 3 **Article - Transportation** 4 12-304. THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO AN ADULT MALE APPLICANT UNDER THE 5 (A) 6 AGE OF 26 YEARS. SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, THE ADMINISTRATION 8 SHALL PROVIDE TO THE SELECTIVE SERVICE ADMINISTRATION IN AN ELECTRONIC 9 FORMAT, FOR PURPOSES OF REGISTRATION WITH THE SELECTIVE SERVICE AS 10 REQUIRED UNDER FEDERAL LAW, THE NECESSARY INFORMATION CONCERNING A 11 MALE APPLICANT WHO APPLIES FOR A DRIVER'S LICENSE OR IDENTIFICATION CARD 12 OR THE RENEWAL OF A DRIVER'S LICENSE OR IDENTIFICATION CARD, INCLUDING 13 THE APPLICANT'S: 14 FULL NAME; (1) **CURRENT ADDRESS:** 15 (2) DATE OF BIRTH: 16 (3) 17 (4) GENDER: 18 (5) DATE OF APPLICATION; AND 19 (6) SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER, IF AVAILABLE. 20 (C) (1) A MALE APPLICANT'S SIGNATURE ON THE APPLICATION INDICATES 21 THAT THE APPLICANT: 22 <del>(I)</del> HAS ALREADY REGISTERED WITH THE SELECTIVE SERVICE 23 ADMINISTRATION; OR 24  $\left( \mathbf{H}\right)$ AUTHORIZES THE ADMINISTRATION TO FORWARD TO THE 25 SELECTIVE SERVICE ADMINISTRATION THE NECESSARY INFORMATION FOR 26 REGISTRATION HAS SELECTED ONE OF THE OPTIONS SPECIFIED IN PARAGRAPH (2) 27 OF THIS SUBSECTION CONCERNING SELECTIVE SERVICE REGISTRATION AND THE 28 FORWARDING OF INFORMATION TO THE SELECTIVE SERVICE ADMINISTRATION 29 UNDER THIS SECTION.

- IN ADDITION TO THE INFORMATION REQUIRED UNDER THIS 31 SUBTITLE OR TITLE 16 OF THIS ARTICLE, AN APPLICATION FORM FOR A DRIVER'S
- 32 LICENSE OR IDENTIFICATION CARD OR RENEWAL OF A DRIVER'S LICENSE OR
- 33 IDENTIFICATION CARD SHALL:
- CONTAIN A STATEMENT THAT A MALE APPLICANT'S
- 35 SIGNATURE CONSTITUTES CONSENT THE MALE APPLICANT:

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1 2	(I) HAS ALREADY REGISTERED WITH THE SELECTIVE SERVICE ADMINISTRATION; OR
3 4	(II) HAS NOT REGISTERED WITH THE SELECTIVE SERVICE ADMINISTRATION AND:
	1. <u>CONSENTS</u> TO FORWARDING THE INFORMATION IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION TO THE SELECTIVE SERVICE ADMINISTRATION; AND
	(II) PROVIDE AN OPPORTUNITY FOR A MALE APPLICANT TO REFUSE TO CONSENT TO THE FORWARDING OF THE INFORMATION IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION TO THE SELECTIVE SERVICE ADMINISTRATION. OR
	2. REFUSES TO CONSENT TO THE FORWARDING OF THE INFORMATION IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION TO THE SELECTIVE SERVICE ADMINISTRATION.
16 17	(D) REFUSAL TO CONSENT TO THE FORWARDING OF THE INFORMATION IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION TO THE SELECTIVE SERVICE ADMINISTRATION MAY NOT BE GROUNDS FOR DENIAL OF AN APPLICATION FOR A DRIVER'S LICENSE OR IDENTIFICATION CARD OR RENEWAL OF A DRIVER'S LICENSE OR IDENTIFICATION CARD.
21 22	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of this Act is contingent on the receipt by the Motor Vehicle Administration of sufficient federal funds to pay the Administration's initial start-up costs for computer programming changes necessary to implement the requirements of Section 1 of this Act related to the reporting of information to the Selective Service Administration.
26 27	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Motor Vehicle Administrator shall initiate and monitor efforts to obtain federal funds for the purposes stated in Section 2 of this Act and shall report promptly to the Department of Legislative Services when federal funds have been received by the Administration and the contingency specified in Section 2 of this Act has been fulfilled.
29 30	SECTION 2. 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to Section 2 of this Act, this Act shall take effect October 1, 2002.
