CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Motor Vehicle Administration - Drivers' Licenses and Identification Cards -**  
3 **Selective Service Administration Registration**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to provide to the  
5 Selective Service Administration certain information concerning male  
6 applicants of a certain age who apply for a driver's license or identification card  
7 under certain circumstances; establishing that a signature on an application for  
8 a driver's license or identification card ~~constitutes consent to~~ indicates that the  
9 applicant has selected one of the options on the application form concerning the  
10 forwarding of certain information to the Selective Service Administration;  
11 requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to provide certain information on a  
12 certain application; providing that an applicant's refusal to consent to certain  
13 information being sent to the Selective Service Administration does not  
14 constitute grounds for denial of a driver's license or identification card;  
15 requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to forward certain information to  
16 the Selective Service Administration in a certain manner; making certain  
17 provisions of this Act contingent on certain federal funding; requiring the Motor  
18 Vehicle Administrator to take certain actions regarding federal funding to  
19 implement certain provisions of this Act; and generally relating to drivers'  
20 licenses and identification cards.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 **Article - Transportation**

4 12-304.

5 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO AN ADULT MALE APPLICANT UNDER THE  
6 AGE OF 26 YEARS.

7 (B) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, THE ADMINISTRATION  
8 SHALL PROVIDE TO THE SELECTIVE SERVICE ADMINISTRATION IN AN ELECTRONIC  
9 FORMAT, FOR PURPOSES OF REGISTRATION WITH THE SELECTIVE SERVICE AS  
10 REQUIRED UNDER FEDERAL LAW, THE NECESSARY INFORMATION CONCERNING A  
11 MALE APPLICANT WHO APPLIES FOR A DRIVER'S LICENSE OR IDENTIFICATION CARD  
12 OR THE RENEWAL OF A DRIVER'S LICENSE OR IDENTIFICATION CARD, INCLUDING  
13 THE APPLICANT'S:

- 14 (1) FULL NAME;
- 15 (2) CURRENT ADDRESS;
- 16 (3) DATE OF BIRTH;
- 17 (4) GENDER;
- 18 (5) DATE OF APPLICATION; AND
- 19 (6) SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER, IF AVAILABLE.

20 (C) (1) A MALE APPLICANT'S SIGNATURE ON THE APPLICATION INDICATES  
21 THAT THE APPLICANT:

22 ~~(I) HAS ALREADY REGISTERED WITH THE SELECTIVE SERVICE~~  
23 ~~ADMINISTRATION; OR~~

24 ~~(II) AUTHORIZES THE ADMINISTRATION TO FORWARD TO THE~~

30 (2) IN ADDITION TO THE INFORMATION REQUIRED UNDER THIS  
31 SUBTITLE OR TITLE 16 OF THIS ARTICLE, AN APPLICATION FORM FOR A DRIVER'S  
32 LICENSE OR IDENTIFICATION CARD OR RENEWAL OF A DRIVER'S LICENSE OR  
33 IDENTIFICATION CARD SHALL:

34 ~~(I) CONTAIN A STATEMENT THAT A MALE APPLICANT'S~~  
35 ~~SIGNATURE CONSTITUTES CONSENT~~ THE MALE APPLICANT:

1                   (I)       HAS ALREADY REGISTERED WITH THE SELECTIVE SERVICE  
 2 ADMINISTRATION; OR

3                   (II)       HAS NOT REGISTERED WITH THE SELECTIVE SERVICE  
 4 ADMINISTRATION AND:

5                               1.       CONSENTS TO FORWARDING THE INFORMATION IN  
 6 SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION TO THE SELECTIVE SERVICE ADMINISTRATION;

8                               (H)       ~~PROVIDE AN OPPORTUNITY FOR A MALE APPLICANT TO~~  
 9 ~~REFUSE TO CONSENT TO THE FORWARDING OF THE INFORMATION IN SUBSECTION~~  
 10 ~~(B) OF THIS SECTION TO THE SELECTIVE SERVICE ADMINISTRATION. OR~~

11                               2.       REFUSES TO CONSENT TO THE FORWARDING OF THE  
 12 INFORMATION IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION TO THE SELECTIVE SERVICE  
 13 ADMINISTRATION.

14       (D)       REFUSAL TO CONSENT TO THE FORWARDING OF THE INFORMATION IN  
 15 SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION TO THE SELECTIVE SERVICE ADMINISTRATION  
 16 MAY NOT BE GROUNDS FOR DENIAL OF AN APPLICATION FOR A DRIVER'S LICENSE OR  
 17 IDENTIFICATION CARD OR RENEWAL OF A DRIVER'S LICENSE OR IDENTIFICATION  
 18 CARD.

19       SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of this Act is  
 20 contingent on the receipt by the Motor Vehicle Administration of sufficient federal  
 21 funds to pay the Administration's initial start-up costs for computer programming  
 22 changes necessary to implement the requirements of Section 1 of this Act related to  
 23 the reporting of information to the Selective Service Administration.

24       SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Motor Vehicle  
 25 Administrator shall initiate and monitor efforts to obtain federal funds for the  
 26 purposes stated in Section 2 of this Act and shall report promptly to the Department  
 27 of Legislative Services when federal funds have been received by the Administration  
 28 and the contingency specified in Section 2 of this Act has been fulfilled.

29       ~~SECTION 2. 4.~~ AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to Section 2 of  
 30 this Act, this Act shall take effect October 1, 2002.
