11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

15 (b) (1) [The Comptroller shall sell] IF contraband tobacco products ARE

16 seized under this title and forfeited [to a State institution, a nonprofit charitable

17 institution, a licensed cigarette wholesaler, or a licensed cigarette manufacturer],

18 THE COMPTROLLER SHALL DISPOSE OF AND DESTROY THE CONTRABAND TOBACCO

19 PRODUCTS in the manner the Comptroller determines.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect

21 July 1, 2002.
