11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Labor and Employment

15 (a) [(1)] Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, whenever an 16 employer has an employee working in a manhole, the employer shall have another 17 employee available in the immediate vicinity of the manhole to give emergency help.

18 [(2) The employee who is available to give emergency help may enter the 19 manhole to give other help.]

20 (b) For a brief period, a qualified employee who is working alone may enter a 21 manhole where cables or equipment are in service to:

- 22 (1) perform an inspection;
- 23 (2) perform housekeeping;
