For fiscal year 2000 and each subsequent fiscal year, the Governor

2 shall include in each year's operating budget funding for the stipends and bonuses 3 provided in this subsection. 4 A classroom teacher who holds a standard professional certificate or (2) 5 an advanced professional certificate who is employed by a county board and who 6 holds a certificate issued by the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards shall receive a stipend from the State in an amount equal to the county grant for 8 national certification, up to a maximum of \$2,000 per qualified teacher. 9 An individual who graduates from an accredited institution of 10 higher education in the top 10% of his or her class, becomes employed by a county board, and remains employed as a classroom teacher in the public school system for a 12 minimum of 3 consecutive years shall receive a salary signing bonus of \$1,000. 13 If the individual leaves employment with the public school 14 system before the end of the 3-year commitment, the individual shall reimburse the 15 State in the amount of \$1,000. 16 (4) A classroom teacher who holds an advanced professional certificate 17 and teaches in a public school identified by the State Board as a reconstitution school, 18 a reconstitution-eligible school, or a challenge school shall receive a stipend from the 19 State in the amount of \$2,000 for each year that the teacher performs satisfactorily in 20 the classroom. 21 An individual who receives a stipend or bonus under subsection (b) of this (c) 22 section may not be deemed an employee of the State. 23 The employer of an individual who receives a stipend or bonus under (d) 24 subsection (b) of this section shall pay the increase in fringe benefit costs associated with the stipend or bonus. 26 (e) The Department shall act as fiscal agent for funds disbursed under this
