3 FOR the purpose of designating certain weeks in certain calendar years during which

- 4 a certain sales and use tax exemption shall apply; altering a certain sales and
- 5 use tax exemption to include certain school supplies; defining a certain term;
- 6 and generally relating to sales and use tax exemptions.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Tax - General

15 11-228.

16 (a) (1) In this section[, "accessory items"] THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE 17 THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

18 (2) "ACCESSORY ITEMS" includes jewelry, watches, watchbands,
19 handbags, handkerchiefs, umbrellas, scarves, ties, headbands, and belt buckles.

20 (3) (I) "SCHOOL SUPPLY" INCLUDES AN ITEM PURCHASED FOR USE IN 21 THE CLASSROOM, SCHOOLWORK COMPLETED AT HOME, OR ANY SCHOOL ACTIVITY.

- 22 (II) "SCHOOL SUPPLY" DOES NOT INCLUDE ANY ELECTRONIC 23 DEVICE.
- 24 (b) (1) The week from [August 10, 2001] AUGUST 10 through [August 16, 25 2001] AUGUST 16 IN EACH YEAR shall be a tax-free week for back-to-school shopping

1 in Maryland during which the exemption under paragraph (2) of this subsection shall2 apply.

3 (2) During the tax-free week for back-to-school shopping established 4 under paragraph (1) of this subsection, the sales and use tax does not apply to the sale 5 of ANY SCHOOL SUPPLY OR any item of clothing or footwear, excluding accessory 6 items, if the taxable price of the SCHOOL SUPPLY OR item of clothing or footwear is 7 less than \$100.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 July 1, 2002.
