### **HOUSE BILL 78**

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Education

4 4-122.

5 (e) Out-of-state agencies that place a child in a foster care home or 6 residential facility in Maryland shall be liable for the costs of such child's education, 7 including transportation.

8 (F) (1) OUT-OF-STATE AGENCIES THAT ARRANGE FOR A CHILD'S
9 PLACEMENT FOR ADOPTION IN MARYLAND, AS DEFINED BY § 5-301 OF THE FAMILY
10 LAW ARTICLE, MAY NOT BE HELD LIABLE FOR THE COSTS OF THE CHILD'S
11 EDUCATION, INCLUDING TRANSPORTATION.

(2) A PLACEMENT FOR ADOPTION UNDER § 5-301 OF THE FAMILY LAW
 ARTICLE DOES NOT HOLD LIABLE UNDER THIS SECTION A FAMILY OR INDIVIDUAL
 WITH WHICH A CHILD HAS BEEN PLACED, FOR THE COSTS OF THE CHILD'S
 EDUCATION, INCLUDING TRANSPORTATION.

20 (j) "Placement for adoption" means the placement of a child to live with a

21 family or individual approved for adoption by a child placement agency, with the

22 intent that the child be adopted by the family or individual.
