CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Highways - Designation - Vietnam Veterans Highway**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Highway Administration to designate a  
4 certain highway as the Vietnam Veterans Highway; and generally relating to  
5 State highway designations.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
7 Article - Transportation  
8 Section 8-650  
9 Annotated Code of Maryland  
10 (2001 Replacement Volume)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Transportation**

14 8-650.

15 (A) The Administration shall designate the portion of Maryland Route 24  
16 located between the U.S. Route 1 Bypass and U.S. Route 40 as the Vietnam Veterans  
17 Memorial Highway.

1 (B) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL DESIGNATE THE PORTION OF MARYLAND  
2 ROUTE 157 KNOWN AS THE PENINSULA EXPRESSWAY AS THE VIETNAM VETERANS  
3 HIGHWAY.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
5 October 1, 2002.
