11 12	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
13	Article - Election Law
14	8-201.
15 16	(a) (1) There shall be a statewide primary election in every even-numbered year.
17	(2) A primary election shall be held:
18 19	(i) In the year in which the Governor is elected, on the second Tuesday after the first Monday in September; and
20 21	(ii) In the year in which the President of the United States is elected, on the first Tuesday in March.
24	(b) In Baltimore City, there shall be a primary election for municipal offices on the second Tuesday following the first Monday in September in the year [following the election of the Governor] THAT THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES IS ELECTED.

## **HOUSE BILL 139**

2 (a) (1) There shall be a statewide general election in each even-numbered 3 year.

4 (2) A statewide general election shall be held on the Tuesday following 5 the first Monday in November.

6 (b) In Baltimore City, there shall be a general election for municipal offices on
7 the [Tuesday following the first Monday in November in the year following the
8 election of the Governor] SAME DAY AS THE GENERAL ELECTION FOR PRESIDENT
9 AND VICE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 11 effect January 1, 2003.
