## Anne Arundel County - Alcoholic Beverages - Multiple Licenses

FOR the purpose of repealing a provision that prohibits the Anne Arundel County
4 Board of License Commissioners from issuing alcoholic beverages licenses, other
5 than certain licenses, to certain restaurant franchisees; establishing that 6 certain Class B alcoholic beverages licensees are eligible for certain additional 7 licenses under certain circumstances; establishing that holders of certain Class $8 \quad$ B or Class H alcoholic beverages licenses that apply to restaurants located in
9 certain areas are eligible for certain additional licenses; clarifying that a 10 franchisor may not have certain interests in more than a certain number of 11 certain licenses; requiring the Board to adopt certain regulations to define a 12 certain term; and generally relating to the issuance of multiple alcoholic
13 beverages licenses in Anne Arundel County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 (h-1) (1) A IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY, A current holder of a Class H alcoholic 4 beverages license, OR A HOLDER AS OF JUNE 1, 2002 OF A CLASS B ALCOHOLIC 5 BEVERAGES LICENSE AS OF JUNE 1, 2002, in Anne Arundel County THAT HAS A 6 RESTRICTION PROHIBITING OFF-SALES, may be issued a second license by the Anne
7 Arundel County Board of License Commissioners if:

9 a Class H (beer and wine) license; and

11 under item (i) of this paragraph is sought OR TO WHICH THE ORIGINAL CLASS B OR
12 CLASS H LICENSE APPLIES is located within:
(i) Each license is a Class H (beer and wine) license or a Class H 34 (beer, wine and liquor) license; and
(ii) The restaurant for which one of the Class H licenses under item 36 (i) of this paragraph is sought is located within:

(6) The Anne Arundel County Economic Development Corporation, in 2 consultation with the Board of License Commissioners for Anne Arundel County:

3 (i) Shall conduct a comprehensive study of the impact of this 4 subsection on the economy of Anne Arundel County; and
(ii) On or before January 1, 2006, shall submit its findings and 6 recommendations to the Anne Arundel County House Delegation, the Anne Arundel 7 County Senate Delegation, the County Executive for Anne Arundel County, and the
8 Anne Arundel County Council.
