1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Board of Public Accountancy - Sunset Extension and Program**
3 **Evaluation**

4 FOR the purpose of continuing the State Board of Public Accountancy in accordance
5 with the provisions of the Maryland Program Evaluation Act (Sunset Law) by
6 extending to a certain date the termination provisions relating to the statutory
7 and regulatory authority of the Board; and requiring that an evaluation of the
8 Board and the statutes and regulations that relate to the Board be performed on
9 or before a certain date.

2 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
3 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

4 **Article - Business Occupations and Professions**

5 2-702.

6 Subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the Maryland
7 Program Evaluation Act, this title and all regulations adopted under this title shall
8 terminate and be of no effect after July 1, [2004] 2015.

9 **Article - State Government**

10 8-403.

11 (a) On or before December 15 of the 2nd year before the evaluation date of a
12 governmental activity or unit, the Legislative Policy Committee, based on a
13 preliminary evaluation, may waive as unnecessary the evaluation required under this
14 section.

15 (b) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (a) of this section, on or before
16 the evaluation date for the following governmental activities or units, an evaluation
17 shall be made of the following governmental activities or units and the statutes and
18 regulations that relate to the governmental activities or units:

19 (56) Public Accountancy, State Board of (§ 2-201 of the Business
20 Occupations and Professions Article: July 1, [2003] 2014);

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
22 October 1, 2002.
