1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Retirement and Pensions - Boards of Supervisors of Elections - Payment of**  
3 **Contributions**

4 FOR the purpose of clarifying the payment of certain contributions for certain  
5 employees of the boards of supervisors of elections who are members of the  
6 Employees' Retirement System or the Employees' Pension System; and  
7 generally relating to the payment of certain contributions for certain employees  
8 of the boards of supervisors of elections who are members of the Employees'  
9 Retirement System or the Employees' Pension System.

10 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
11 Article - State Personnel and Pensions  
12 Section 21-307(a)  
13 Annotated Code of Maryland  
14 (1997 Replacement Volume and 2001 Supplement)

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article - State Personnel and Pensions**

18 21-307.

19 (a) For a permanent employee of a board of supervisors of elections who is a  
20 member of the Employees' Retirement System or the Employees' Pension System, the  
21 county where the member is employed shall:

1                   (1)       pay to the Board of Trustees OR THE CENTRAL PAYROLL BUREAU the  
2 employer contributions otherwise required to be made by the State on behalf of the  
3 member; and

4                   (2)       deduct from the compensation payable to the member and pay to the  
5 Board of Trustees OR THE CENTRAL PAYROLL BUREAU the required member  
6 contributions.

7       SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
8 July 1, 2002.
