- 22 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 23 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 24 Article State Personnel and Pensions
- 25 2-515.
- 26 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO THE TRI-COUNTY COUNCIL FOR SOUTHERN
- 27 MARYLAND, THE TRI-COUNTY COUNCIL FOR WESTERN MARYLAND, THE TRI-COUNTY
- 28 COUNCIL FOR THE LOWER EASTERN SHORE OF MARYLAND, AND THE MID-SHORE
- 29 REGIONAL COUNCIL.

- 1 (B) AN EMPLOYEE OF A COUNCIL SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION MAY ENROLL
- 2 AND PARTICIPATE IN THE HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFIT OPTIONS ESTABLISHED
- 3 UNDER THE PROGRAM WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE COUNCIL.
- 4 (C) A COUNCIL SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION SHALL:
- 5 (1) PAY TO THE STATE THE TOTAL COSTS RESULTING FROM THE
- 6 PARTICIPATION OF ITS EMPLOYEES IN THE PROGRAM; AND
- 7 (2) DETERMINE THE EXTENT TO WHICH THE COUNCIL WILL SUBSIDIZE
- 8 PARTICIPATION OF ITS EMPLOYEES IN THE PROGRAM.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 July 1, 2002.
