## 1 Article - Criminal Law 2 8-803. 3 A person may not intentionally issue, sell, or give to an unauthorized (a) (1) person a ticket or instrument for the transfer from a conveyance on one passenger 5 line or route to a conveyance on another line or route of the same or a different carrier. 6 Unless authorized to do so, a person may not intentionally receive a 7 ticket or instrument for the transfer from a conveyance on one passenger line or route 8 to a conveyance on another line or route of the same or a different carrier. A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on 10 conviction is subject to: 11 (1) for the first violation, a fine [not less than \$10 and] not exceeding 12 \$100; and 13 for each subsequent violation, imprisonment not exceeding 6 months 14 or a fine not [less than \$100] EXCEEDING \$1,000 or both. 15 **Article - Natural Resources** 16 8-724.1. 17 A person may not: [(a)]18 (1) Interfere with the use of a public landing; 19 (2) Do anything to destroy the usefulness of the public landing; or 20 Damage a wharf or structure erected on the wharf by the State, a (3) 21 county, or a person under a written agreement with a State unit or a county for public 22 benefit. 23 [(b)]A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on 24 conviction is subject to a fine of not less than \$25.] 25 8-2001. 26 Any person who violates any provision of this title is guilty of a 27 misdemeanor.
