3	FOR the purpose of altering the age at which a minor may donate blood without the consent of a parent; and generally relating to the age a minor may donate blood.
5 6 7 8 9	BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article - Health - General Section 20-101 Annotated Code of Maryland (2000 Replacement Volume and 2001 Supplement)
10 11	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
12	Article - Health - General
13	20-101.
14 15	Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a minor who is at least [17] 16 years old, without the consent of a parent, may give blood to a program that:
16	(1) Is voluntary

- Is voluntary; 16 (1)
- 17 (2) Does not pay money for the blood; and
- Is approved by: 18 (3)
- 19 The American Association of Blood Banks; or (i)
- 20 (ii) The American Red Cross.
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 22 October 1, 2002.
