2 **Charles County - Palm Readers, Fortune Tellers, and Soothsayers -**
3 **Licensing**

4 FOR the purpose of repealing certain licensing requirements for palm readers,
5 fortune tellers, soothsayers, and other similar persons in Charles County; and
6 generally relating to the licensing of palm readers, fortune tellers, and
7 soothsayers in Charles County.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article 24 - Political Subdivisions - Miscellaneous Provisions**

17 Notwithstanding any other sections of the Business Regulation Article, in
18 Charles County any palm reader, fortune-teller, soothsayer, or similar person shall
19 apply to the Board of County Commissioners of Charles County for a license to carry
20 on business. The license shall be issued by the Board only upon proof that the person
21 has been a resident, taxpayer, and property owner of Charles County for at least 18
22 months prior to the application for the license. The annual fee for the license shall be
23 \$250, and the license shall be issued by the Clerk of the Circuit Court and may be
24 revoked by the Board for good cause.]

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
26 October 1, 2002.
