- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 Notwithstanding any other sections of the Business Regulation Article, in
- 18 Charles County any palm reader, fortune-teller, soothsayer, or similar person shall
- 19 apply to the Board of County Commissioners of Charles County for a license to carry
- 20 on business. The license shall be issued by the Board only upon proof that the person
- 21 has been a resident, taxpayer, and property owner of Charles County for at least 18
- 22 months prior to the application for the license. The annual fee for the license shall be
- 23 \$250, and the license shall be issued by the Clerk of the Circuit Court and may be
- 24 revoked by the Board for good cause.]
