19 20 21	Notwithstanding any other sections of the Business Regulation Article, in Charles County any palm reader, fortune-teller, soothsayer, or similar person shall apply to the Board of County Commissioners of Charles County for a license to carry on business. The license shall be issued by the Board only upon proof that the person has been a resident, taxpayer, and property owner of Charles County for at least 18 months prior to the application for the license. The annual fee for the license shall be

- $1\ \$250,$  and the license shall be issued by the Clerk of the Circuit Court and may be  $2\$  revoked by the Board for good cause.]
- 3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 4 October 1, 2002.
