CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Correctional Services - Inmates - Indecent Exposure**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting an inmate from ~~willfully, intentionally~~ lewdly,
4 lasciviously, and indecently exposing certain parts of the inmate's body to
5 certain persons under certain circumstances; providing that certain words and
6 phrases retain their judicially determined ~~meaning~~ meanings; providing for
7 certain penalties; and generally relating to inmates and indecent exposure.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Correctional Services

2 8-803.

3 (A) WORDS AND PHRASES IN THIS SECTION THAT DESCRIBE THE
4 COMMON-LAW CRIME OF INDECENT EXPOSURE SHALL RETAIN THEIR JUDICIALLY
5 DETERMINED ~~MEANING~~ MEANINGS EXCEPT TO THE EXTENT EXPRESSLY OR
6 IMPLICITLY CHANGED IN THIS SECTION.

7 (B) AN INMATE MAY NOT ~~WILLFULLY, INTENTIONALLY, WITH INTENT TO~~
8 ANNOY, ABUSE, TORMENT, HARASS, OR EMBARRASS A CORRECTIONAL OFFICER OR
9 AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL, LEWDLY, LASCIVIOUSLY, AND INDECENTLY EXPOSE
10 PRIVATE PARTS OF THE INMATE'S BODY IN THE PRESENCE OF A THE CORRECTIONAL
11 OFFICER OR AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL.

12 (C) AN INMATE WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR
13 AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 3 YEARS OR A
14 FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR BOTH.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
16 October 1, 2002.
