- 3 (A) WORDS AND PHRASES IN THIS SECTION THAT DESCRIBE THE
- 4 COMMON-LAW CRIME OF INDECENT EXPOSURE <u>SHALL</u> RETAIN THEIR JUDICIALLY
- 5 DETERMINED MEANING MEANINGS EXCEPT TO THE EXTENT EXPRESSLY OR
- 6 IMPLICITLY CHANGED IN THIS SECTION.
- 7 (B) AN INMATE MAY NOT <del>WILLFULLY, INTENTIONALLY</del>, WITH INTENT TO
- 8 <u>ANNOY, ABUSE, TORMENT, HARASS, OR EMBARRASS A CORRECTIONAL OFFICER OR</u>
- 9 AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL, LEWDLY, LASCIVIOUSLY, AND INDECENTLY EXPOSE
- 10 PRIVATE PARTS OF THE INMATE'S BODY IN THE PRESENCE OF A THE CORRECTIONAL
- 11 OFFICER OR AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL.
- 12 (C) AN INMATE WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR
- 13 AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 3 YEARS OR A
- 14 FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR BOTH.
- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 16 October 1, 2002.
