- 19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III,
- 20 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or
- 21 apply to the salary or compensation of the State's Attorney for St. Mary's County, the
- 22 Treasurer of St. Mary's County, the Sheriff of St. Mary's County, the Judges of the
- 23 Orphans' Court for St. Mary's County, the President of the Board of County
- 24 Commissioners of St. Mary's County, or the County Commissioners of St. Mary's
- 25 County in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act
- 26 concerning the salary or compensation of the State's Attorney for St. Mary's County,
- 27 the Treasurer of St. Mary's County, the Sheriff of St. Mary's County, the Judges of the
- 28 Orphans' Court for St. Mary's County, the President of the Board of County
- 29 Commissioners of St. Mary's County, and the County Commissioners of St. Mary's
- 30 County shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.
