- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 19 (J) A CUSTODIAN MAY DENY INSPECTION OF THAT PART OF A PUBLIC 20 RECORD THAT CONTAINS:
- 21 (1) RATES OR PROPOSED RATES GENERATED, RECEIVED, OR
- 22 NEGOTIATED BY THE MARYLAND PORT ADMINISTRATION OR ANY PRIVATE
- 23 OPERATING COMPANY CREATED BY IT, INCLUDING RATES IN STEVEDORING AND
- 24 TERMINAL SERVICES CONTRACTS;
- 25 (2) A PROPOSAL GENERATED, RECEIVED, OR NEGOTIATED BY THE

- 1 (3) RESEARCH OR DATA COMPILED FOR THE MARYLAND PORT
- 2 ADMINISTRATION OR ANY PRIVATE OPERATING COMPANY CREATED BY IT TO ASSESS
- 3 ITS COMPETITIVE POSITION WITH RESPECT TO OTHER PORTS.
- 4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
- 5 effect June 1, 2002.
