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A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Calvert County - Extension of Task Force to Study the Infrastructure Needs**  
3 **of Private Communities in Calvert County**

4 FOR the purpose of continuing the Task Force to Study the Infrastructure Needs of  
5 Private Communities in Calvert County by extending to a certain date the  
6 termination provision relating to the authority of the Task Force; and generally  
7 relating to the extension of the Task Force to Study the Infrastructure Needs of  
8 Private Communities in Calvert County.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Chapter 544 of the Acts of 2001**

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
19 MARYLAND, That:

20 (a) There is a Task Force to Study the Infrastructure Needs of Private  
21 Communities in Calvert County.

22 (b) (1) The Task Force shall consist of the following nine members:

23 (i) Five members appointed by the County Commissioners of  
24 Calvert County, with each County Commissioner appointing one of the five members;

25 (ii) Two members appointed by the Senators from the Senate of  
26 Maryland who represent Calvert County; and

1 (iii) Two members appointed by the Delegates from the House of  
2 Delegates who represent Calvert County.

3 (2) Each member of the Task Force shall be a resident of a private  
4 community in Calvert County, or have other knowledge or expertise relating to the  
5 infrastructure needs of private communities in Calvert County.

6 (c) The County Commissioners of Calvert County shall designate the  
7 chairman of the Task Force.

8 (d) The Task Force shall be staffed by personnel from the office of the County  
9 Commissioners of Calvert County.

10 (e) Each member of the Task Force shall serve without compensation but shall  
11 be entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel  
12 Regulations.

13 (f) The Task Force shall:

14 (1) Conduct a comprehensive survey of the infrastructure needs of  
15 private communities in Calvert County;

16 (2) Hold public hearings as necessary to solicit input from residents of  
17 Calvert County on issues relating to the private communities' infrastructure needs;

18 (3) Determine what State and local government resources are available,  
19 and what additional resources are needed, to address the identified infrastructure  
20 needs; and

21 (4) Make recommendations on how available resources can be used to  
22 meet the identified infrastructure needs, and on the order in which the infrastructure  
23 needs should be addressed.

24 (g) The Task Force shall submit a report on its preliminary findings and  
25 recommendations to the County Commissioners of Calvert County and, in accordance  
26 with § 2-1246 of State Government Article, to the Calvert County Delegation to the  
27 Maryland General Assembly, on or before November 1, 2001, and shall submit a final  
28 report on or before December 31, 2002.

29 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
30 June 1, 2001. It shall remain effective for a period of [1 year] 2 YEARS and 7 months  
31 and, at the end of [December 31, 2002] DECEMBER 31, 2003, with no further action  
32 required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force  
33 and effect.

34 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take  
35 effect June 1, 2002.
