A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Calvert County - Economic Development Authority**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the method of appointing members of the Calvert County
4 Economic Development Authority; requiring the County Commissioners of
5 Calvert County to determine the number of members and composition of the
6 Calvert County Economic Development Authority; and generally relating to the
7 Calvert County Economic Development Authority.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

11 Article 5 - Public Local Laws of Maryland
12 (1986 Edition and July 1991 Supplement, as amended)
13 (As enacted by Chapter 86 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1994, as
14 amended by Chapter 50 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1996)

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article 5 - Calvert County**

18 11-204.

19 (a) The authority is a body corporate and politic and is constituted a public
20 instrumentality of the county. The exercise by the authority of the powers conferred
21 by the provisions of this subtitle shall be deemed to be the performance of essential
22 governmental functions. [The authority consists of 9 members, all of whom] ALL
23 MEMBERS OF THE AUTHORITY shall be registered voters of Calvert County, appointed
24 for 3 year terms by the county commissioners, subject to the approval of the county
25 delegation to the General Assembly. THE COMPOSITION AND NUMBER OF MEMBERS
26 OF THE AUTHORITY SHALL BE DETERMINED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS. [The
27 members shall include:

28 (1) A member of the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County;

- 1 (2) Two representatives from the financial community;
- 2 (3) The superintendent of schools or the superintendent's designee;
- 3 (4) A designee of the Calvert County Economic Development
4 Commission;
- 5 (5) Two representatives of the local commercial and industrial sectors;
6 and
- 7 (6) Two other persons to be recommended by the authority and approved
8 by the Board of County Commissioners.]

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
10 effect October 1, 2002.
