

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 16 **Article - Education** 17 3-301. 18 The Calvert County Board consists of five voting members and one (a) 19 nonvoting student member. 20 The five voting members of the Calvert County Board shall be elected at a 21 general election as required by subsections (d) and (f) of this section. 22 (c) (1) (i) A member from a county commissioner district shall be a 23 resident of the district. 24 (ii) A member from a county commissioner district who no longer 25 resides in the district may not continue as a member of the County Board.
