## A BILL ENTITLED

I AN ACT concerning	
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2	Provision and Installation of Smoke Alarm Devices and Batteries - Civil
3	Immunity

- 4 FOR the purpose of providing certain entities with immunity from civil liability
- 5 arising out of a defect in the design, manufacture, maintenance, or operation of
- a smoke alarm device or battery that is provided free of charge; providing
- 7 certain firefighters and fire companies with immunity from civil liability arising
- 8 out of the installation of a smoke alarm device or battery if the installation is
- 9 provided free of charge and if, with respect to the installation of a smoke alarm
- device, the device is tested after installation; specifying that the immunity
- provided in this Act does not affect the liability of the manufacturer, distributor,
- or retailer of a smoke alarm device or battery; establishing that this Act does not
- create certain new causes of action or substantive legal rights; establishing that
- this Act does not affect certain immunities from civil liability or defenses;
- providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to immunity
- from civil liability for certain entities and individuals who provide or install
- smoke alarm devices or batteries free of charge.

- 23 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 24 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 27 (A) THE FOLLOWING ENTITIES ARE IMMUNE FROM CIVIL LIABILITY FOR
- 28 PERSONAL INJURY, WRONGFUL DEATH, PROPERTY DAMAGE, OR OTHER LOSS
- 29 ARISING OUT OF A DEFECT IN THE DESIGN, MANUFACTURE, MAINTENANCE, OR

- 6 (2) A UNIT OF STATE OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT OR ANY OTHER 7 GOVERNMENTAL UNIT IN THE STATE; AND

- 9 (B) THE FOLLOWING ENTITIES AND INDIVIDUALS ARE IMMUNE FROM CIVIL

- 22 SMOKE ALARM DEVICE OR BATTERY.
- 23 (E) (1) THIS SECTION DOES NOT CREATE, AND MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED AS
- 24 CREATING, A NEW CAUSE OF ACTION OR SUBSTANTIVE LEGAL RIGHT AGAINST AN
- 25 INDIVIDUAL OR ENTITY IDENTIFIED IN THIS SECTION.
- 26 (2) THIS SECTION DOES NOT AFFECT, AND MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED AS
- 27 AFFECTING, ANY IMMUNITIES FROM CIVIL LIABILITY OR DEFENSES ESTABLISHED
- 28 BY ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THE CODE OR AVAILABLE AT COMMON LAW, TO WHICH
- 29 AN INDIVIDUAL OR ENTITY IDENTIFIED IN THIS SECTION MAY BE ENTITLED.
- 30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be
- 31 construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have
- 32 any effect on or application to any cause of action arising before the effective date of
- 33 this Act.
- 34 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 35 October 1, 2002.
