CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Caroline County - State's Attorney - Salary**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the State's Attorney for Caroline County;  
4 providing that this Act does not apply to the salary of the incumbent State's  
5 Attorney; and generally relating to the salary of the State's Attorney for  
6 Caroline County.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
8 Article 10 - Legal Officials  
9 Section 40(f)  
10 Annotated Code of Maryland  
11 (1998 Replacement Volume and 2001 Supplement)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article 10 - Legal Officials**

2 40.

3 (f) In Caroline County, (1) the State's Attorney's annual salary is ~~[\$70,000]~~  
4 ~~\$80,000~~ SHALL BE 80 PERCENT OF THE SALARY OF A JUDGE OF THE DISTRICT COURT  
5 OF MARYLAND.

6 (2) The State's Attorney shall receive expenses as provided by the  
7 Standard State Travel Regulations.

8 (3) The State's Attorney may not engage in the private practice of law.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III,  
10 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or  
11 apply to the salary or compensation of the State's Attorney for Caroline County in  
12 office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the  
13 salary or compensation of the State's Attorney for Caroline County shall take effect at  
14 the beginning of the next following term of office.

15 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
16 October 1, 2002.
