- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- In Caroline County, (1) the State's Attorney's annual salary is [\$70,000] (f)
- 17 \$80,000.
- The State's Attorney shall receive expenses as provided by the (2)
- 19 Standard State Travel Regulations.
- 20 (3) The State's Attorney may not engage in the private practice of law.
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III,
- 22 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or
- 23 apply to the salary or compensation of the State's Attorney for Caroline County in
- 24 office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the
- 25 salary or compensation of the State's Attorney for Caroline County shall take effect at
- 26 the beginning of the next following term of office.

- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 2002.
