- 3 (A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A PERSON 4 MAY NOT:
- 5 (1) REQUEST OR REQUIRE THAT AN INDIVIDUAL PROVIDE THE 6 INDIVIDUAL'S SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER TO THE PERSON;
- 7 (2) SELL OR PURCHASE THE SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER OF AN 8 INDIVIDUAL; OR
- 9 (3) REFUSE TO DO BUSINESS WITH AN INDIVIDUAL BECAUSE THE 10 INDIVIDUAL HAS REFUSED TO PROVIDE THE PERSON THE INDIVIDUAL'S SOCIAL 11 SECURITY NUMBER.
- 12 (B) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A REQUEST MADE BY A PERSON FOR 13 THE PURPOSE OF MEETING A LEGAL REQUIREMENT THAT MANDATES USE OF A

- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 16 January 1, 2004.
